Yavapai County reports 148 COVID-19 Cases and 8 deaths since Wednesday, September 14th, 2022. There have been 54,980 positive cases and 1,290 deaths since the beginning of the pandemic. Yavapai Regional Medical Center reports 12 COVID patients, VVMC reports 1 patient, and the VA reports 0 patients.
